LODGING / CABINS

Cabins are located along the lake within easy walking distance to the dining hall and activities. Each cabin has its own bathroom. The bathroom has 2 sinks, 2 toilets and 2 private showers. Cabins have twin beds (anywhere from 10-18) and electrical outlets throughout the cabin and in the bathroom. Cabins are not heated.

FAMILY CABINS

Families of 3 or more will probably have their own cabin depending on availability.

COUPLES CABINS

Some couples will share a cabin with one or two other couples. These cabins have 10-18 beds, far more than you will need, and a bathroom with 2 sinks, 2 toilets and 2 private showers.

In addition to the regular cabins, there are 9 private cabins ideally suited for couples that have one queen or king bed and a private bathroom. The cabin assignment process for these private cabins will first take into consideration special circumstances and will then be assigned using a lottery system from the list of other registered couples requesting private quarters.

WOMEN/GIRLS OR MEN/BOYS ONLY CABINS

Women and girls may choose to stay in a Women/Girls Only Cabin with up to 6 persons per cabin. Likewise, men and boys may choose to stay in a Men/Boys Only Cabin with up to 6 persons. Youth under 14 years old must have an accompanying adult in the cabin. There will be at least 2 adults in each cabin.

HIGH SCHOOL CABIN

The high school cabin is for any high school student 14-18 years old. There will be at least 2 adult youth advisors in the youth cabin. Please note 'High School Cabin' on your registration form if your youth is interested. Please review the MLUC Youth Policy on Violence, Sexual Activity, Drugs and Alcohol with any youth you bring to camp.
