

UU COMMUNITY WEEKEND

YOUTH POLICY ON VIOLENCE, SEXUAL ACTIVITY, ALCOHOL AND DRUGS

There is to be no violence, sexual activity, possession or use of alcohol, tobacco, illegal drugs, or weapons, or misuse of legal drugs by youth while attending the UU Community Weekend.

This policy applies to all youth. A youth is defined as a person 14-18 years old or a person in high school participating in youth activities.

An adult member of MLUC shall, upon consultation with those in charge of the weekend, determine whether a violation has occurred.

When a violation is determined to have occurred:

- a. A parent/guardian of the youth will be requested to immediately escort the violator off the premises.
- b. If the youth is unable for any reason to immediately leave the premises, he/she will be isolated in the presence of a parent/guardian or an adult MLUC member until he/she can leave.
- c. Youth and/or their parents/guardian agree to forfeit any registration and activity fees and agree to reimburse the Church for any expenses incurred to enforce this policy, including travel.
- d. The MLUC UU Community Weekend Committee and Youth Leader will review as soon as possible all incidents involving this policy and will determine appropriate follow-up.
