Pathway of Spiritual Maturity

MLUC hosts a number of classes throughout the church year that explore “Faith Development” and “Faith In Action.” Brochures that describe the scheduled classes in can be found at the Welcome Table.

Meditation Group I

Every Sunday, 8:30-9:45 a.m.

Meditation Group II

Every Sunday, 11:30 a.m.-12:00 p.m.

New participants from the church and the larger community are welcome. This group is open to everyone, beginners and experienced meditators alike. We gather, greet each other, and take a few minutes to center ourselves. Then we share a short reading to enhance our practice and sit for 20 minutes.
