

THE MEMORIAL GARDEN

The **Memorial Garden at Main Line Unitarian Church** is a quiet and beautiful place for remembering church members, friends, close relatives, companions, or partners who have died.



The Memorial Garden is an inviting natural environment, with trees, winding paths, and rustic benches, where loved ones can be honored with a Memorial Plaque. The plaque is surrounded by natural ground cover, and provides a simple, unobtrusive reminder of a loved one's life.

The Memorial Plaque bears the name, year of birth, and year of death of the person being remembered. Friends and family may select a location for the plaque at least 18 inches from the edge of the path.

THE MEMORIAL GARDEN AT MAIN LINE UNITARIAN CHURCH

Memorial Plaques are 5 x 8 inches in size. Names and dates are displayed in raised cast letters. Plaques are attached to a granite stone sunk into the ground, and left raised three inches above the garden floor.

All plaques are identical in size and price. The fee of \$850 includes the granite stone, bronze plaque, and installation. Every effort is made to provide space around a plaque for members of the same family.

Ashes may also be interred in the memorial garden at the family's request. The ashes are interred directly into the ground without the use of urns, boxes, or any plastic container.

A Minister will conduct appropriate services in partnership with the wishes of the family.

You may pre-pay for your own memorial plaque or order one for a loved one using the attached form.

Administration of the Memorial Garden

The Memorial Garden Committee is responsible for care and maintenance of the Garden. Volunteers interested in helping with the Memorial Garden are appreciated.

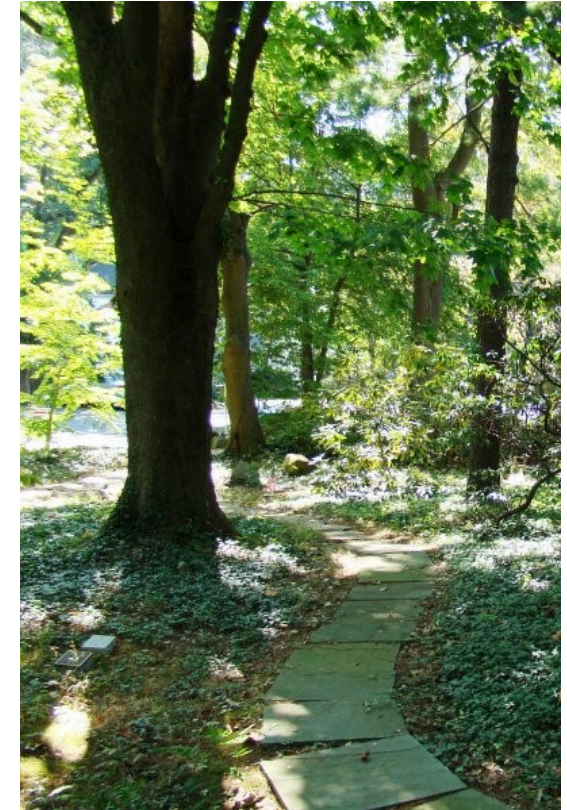
Memorial Gifts
